

Theologos Coordinator

Wycliffe Hall is seeking to appoint a Theologos Coordinator for 4 hours per week during weeks 0-8 of Oxford term time to assist with the running of Wycliffe Hall's Theologos Programme. The Theologos Programme is a theological learning community that Full-Time CTS (Certificate in Theological Studies) students can apply to be a part of alongside their academic studies. The Theologos Programme comprises a number of extra-curricular activities aimed at fostering a significant sense of community and camaraderie among the students participating in it, including: daily chapel attendance; a weekly reading group; fireside chats; termly dinners; cultural visits. The Theologos Coordinator will work with and report to the Tutor for the Theologos Programme, Dr Max Baker-Hytch, to assist with the running of these various activities. The Theologos Programme Coordinator's activities would take roughly 4 hours per week during weeks 0-8 of Oxford term times, or in other words, 108 hours per year.

Wycliffe Hall is an Evangelical College in the heart of Oxford and is a Permanent Private Hall of the University of Oxford, committed to excellence in teaching and research. We have around 130 students, of whom about 60 are Church of England ordinands. Students study for undergraduate and postgraduate qualifications from the certificate level to the doctorate, and come from a wide variety of backgrounds.

The post is a part-time contract for one year (4 hours per week during weeks 0-8 of Oxford term time; i.e. 108 hours per year). The salary is £2,500 per annum.

Responsibilities:

- Leading a reading group which takes place from 8.20-9.20am on Tuesdays during termtime
- Co-leading the Theologos Programme induction meeting in Welcome Week alongside the Tutor for the Theologos Programme
- Booking guest speakers for the fireside chats and hosting the fireside chats, of which we aim to put on 2-3 per term, each lasting one hour
- Attending the termly dinner
- Attending any cultural visits during the year e.g., in a typical year this might comprise a trip to the Kilns before Christmas and a trip to the British Museum in Trinity Term
- Meeting for an hour at the end of each term with the Tutor for the Theologos
 Programme to review how the Programme is going
- Monitoring the Theologos budget

Remuneration

The salary is £2,500 for 4 hours per week during weeks 0-8 of Oxford term time; i.e. 108 hours per year. It is for a one-year contract.

The appointee will be entitled to free College meals one day a week, except when the kitchen is closed.

The normal place of work is Wycliffe Hall, 52-54 Banbury Road, Oxford.
